- Driver's license and vehicle registration will be **REQUIRED** as proof of residency for participation (the address on both must match and will be **STRICTLY** enforced)
- No trailers, no box vans, no u-hauls or 10 Wheelers.

Materials That Will Be Accepted At NO COST to Owasco Residents

- HOUSEHOLD/GARAGE ITEMS, MATTRESS/BOX SPRING, OLD FURNITURE, WOOD,
- METAL, OLD PATIO FUNITURE, OLD CARPETS.
 THE TOWN RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT EXCEPT ANY ITEM.
