- **Driver's license and vehicle registration** will be **REQUIRED** as proof of residency for participation (the address on both must match and will be **STRICTLY** enforced)
- No trailers, no box vans, no u-hauls or 10 Wheelers.

## • Materials That Will Be Accepted At **NO COST** to Owasco Residents

- HOUSEHOLD/GARAGE ITEMS, MATTRESS/BOX SPRING, OLD FURNITURE, WOOD,
- METAL, OLD PATIO FUNITURE, OLD CARPETS.  
**THE TOWN RESERVES THE RIGHT TO NOT EXCEPT ANY ITEM.**

## • E-waste Items to be accepted for Owasco Residents

**Electronics: Free items: Computer, Monitor, DVD, VCR, Printers, (refer to flyer for additional items)**

**TV's are accepted for a fee:**

**27" or under \$20.00 TV's over 27" \$40.00**

**Documents in boxes** – if the documents that you want destroyed are kept in storage boxes, and you wish to keep the physical boxes your documents are stored in, **you will need to transfer the documents to another cardboard box beforehand.**

**Paper clips, staples, folders, and envelopes** – these are all safe for our shredding machines and can be included with the documents.

The town will also be hosting A Town Clean up Event May 14, 2022- 7am-1:00pm

**Note: The hours of the Cleanup Event are different from the shredding event.**

- Answering Machines
- Telephones
- Cell Phones & Chargers
- All Computer Accessories (Mice, Keyboards, Webcams, Speakers, Microphones)
- GPS Units
- PDA's, Tablets, MP3 Players
- Scanners
- Radios, CD/DVD/VHS Players etc.
- Storage Devices (External Hard Drives, Solid State Drives, SD Cards, Memory Cards, Card Readers, etc.)
- Audio Equipment (Speakers, Microphones, etc.)
- Video Equipment (Cameras, Video Cameras, Web Cams, Recording Devices
- Typewriters
- Lead-acid Batteries, Ni-Cad Batteries ONLY

## Unacceptable Items

- Cathode Ray Tube Devices (Old TVs, Monitors) Lamps/Bulbs
- Small appliances, Batteries not listed as acceptable, NO CAR BATTERIES
