Per NYS Agriculture and Markets Law (Article 7)

Once a dog is licensed, the owner will receive a paper license and metal tag with a number identifying the dog as being licensed in the Town of Owasco

- *The license is good for 1 year.
- *Each year, the dog license must be renewed in the same month as the original dog license month.
- *Reminder notices will be mailed out the last week of the previous month or the first week of month that the license is due.
- *The original registration/license month will remain with the dog for life.
- *The original tag number will remain with the dog for life.
- *A valid rabies certificate must be provided (when required) at the dog license renewal date.
- *If a rabies vaccination has expired or is about to expire (within 30 days), a current rabies certificate must be provided in order to process and renew the dog license for that particular year.

Reasons why dogs are required to be licensed:

- -It's a NYS Law!
- -A permanent paper trail is created if any disputes arise in the future.
- -Public health is protected by the initial and continuing awareness against RABIES, etc.
- -Revenues are generated for dog control and dog protection services; protection of the community, property, domestic animals and deer from possible attacks/damage.
- -An efficient and essential means of identifying a particular dog and/or the owner, in case of a lost or found situation.
