<u>RESOLUTION 20-176</u> To Authorize the Town Supervisor to sign an Easement with Frank Mancuso for property at Meadow Lane, Tax Map No. 123.08-2-79.1.

WHEREAS, by Deed dated 10.29.20 and recorded 11.20.20 in the Cayuga County Clerk's Office in Book 3961 Page 296, Frank Mancuso took title of property described as: Meadow Lane, Tax Map No. 123.08-2-79.1, 14.2 acres;

WHEREAS, this property was generally known and referred to as Phase 3 of the Oakridge Heights Subdivision;

WHEREAS, in the past several years the prior owner has proposed different variations of Subdivision for Phase 3 of the Oakridge Heights Subdivision;

WHEREAS, most recently, on 3.5.14 the Town of Owasco Planning Board granted Conditional Preliminary and Final Subdivision approval of the Oakridge Heights Phase 3 comprising five (5) residential parcels;

WHEREAS, it does not appear that the subdivision was finalized and the parcel at Meadow Lane, Tax Map No. 123.08-2-79.1, containing approximately 14.05 acres was sold as one parcel;

WHEREAS, by deed dated 6.7.19 and recorded on 6.18.19 at the Cayuga County Clerk's Office in Book 3735 Page 56, Meadow Lane, Tax Map No. 123.08-2-2, containing 1.6 acres, the Town of Owasco took title to the parcel containing the detention pond where the Town has a permanent storm drainage easement;

WHEREAS, the access to the Town's parcel to maintain the detention pond has been from the paper street from the intersection of Meadow Lane and Fairway Drive which is part of the original Phase 3 of the Oakridge Heights Subdivision;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town to expressly obtain and easement from the current owner; and

WHEREAS, Frank Mancuso, in consideration for executing an Easement to the Town is requesting that the Town perform some drainage work near the intersection of Meadow Lane and Fairway Drive and specifically extend and cover two culverts under the driveway to the blend on the east side of the driveway. The extension is approximately 30'. Also on the left side of the driveway the Town will extend the current culvert so the Town can have proper ingress and egress to the retention pond. **RESOLVED,** the Town Board authorizes the Town Supervisor to sign an Easement with Frank Mancuso for property at Meadow Lane, Tax Map No. 123.08-2-79.1 to be prepared by the Town Attorney.
