Reducing Town Court- When the NYS Comptrollers

* With the new centralized court room located at the Cayuga County Jail all arraignments are now being held for the whole county in this one location. The Town Justice will no longer do arraignments on an on call in bases here at the town. This possibly leaving the town with no need for two judges, this was also recommended by the NYS Comptrollers.

Update on GAC Project-

* The building to host the new permeant tanks has been sent for bids with bid to be opened on March 18, 2020.

Update on Wet Land Restoration Project

* In December 2019 the town received a consent order from the DEC to restore the wetlands that the building years ago infringed upon, along with contaminated soil that was discovered in the construction of the Micro Cystin project at the town highway garage, 6346 East Lake Rd. The DEC has agreed to let the town bury 60% of the soil but the remaining 40% must be trucked away to an approved landfill.

Update on Water Main Replacement Project –

* The town was hoping to extend the water main replacement project to include Owasco Rd, between Adams Ave & Green Shutters, however the price from the original contractor came in higher than expected and will now go out for bid.

Update on Barracuda Anti-Virus & Archiving

* Ed will watch for any issues involving the installation of this program.

Update with the Town of Fleming, regards to water contract

*The Town of Owasco supplies water to the Town Fleming the meter is very old and failing, it was agreed upon by all of the Town Council to replace it at a cost of approximately \$4000.00.

Description of Change(s):

1. As stated in Changer Order No. 1, contaminated soils from previous work need to be disposed of in accordance with NYSDEC guidance.

Reason for Change(s):

1. Approximately 1,300 CY of soils were separated and stockpiled for sampling and assessment to determine the extent of which soils needed to be landfilled. In accordance with NYSDEC guidance, approximately 800 CY of soil will require landfilling. The total final cost for soil disposal is not known as it will be tabulated after the final volume is determined by weight at the landfill. The cost of the soil disposal will not exceed 70 percent of the original cost for the 1,300 CY estimate (\$81,500). North Country Contractors will only charge the Town of Owasco based on the actual volume of soil that is disposed of based on Time and Material basis.
