### RESOLUTION 22-073 TOWN OF OWASCO TOWN COUNCIL RESOLUTION INTRODUCING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2022 ENTITLED "MORATORIUM ON COMMERCIAL WIND AND SOLAR ENERGY FACILITIES"

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Owasco ("Town Council") has found that it is necessary and prudent to adopt a new local law enacting a moratorium on commercial wind and solar energy facilities for the purposes of allowing time for the Town to draft, review and implement possible regulations for commercial wind and solar development; and

WHEREAS, this proposed Local Law is a "Type II" action and is not an action reasonably anticipated to "affect the environment" pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(30) of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQR), and thus is exempt from environmental review thereunder; and

WHEREAS, this action involves the adoption or amendment of a zoning ordinance or local law and is therefore subject to review by the Cayuga County Planning Board pursuant to General Municipal Law § 239-m(3)(ii); and

### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein at length.
- 2. The Town Council hereby introduces Proposed Local Law No. 2 of 2022 in the form annexed hereto for consideration and adoption.
- 3. The Town Council hereby finds and determines that the within action is a Type "II" action and not reasonably anticipated to "affect the environment" pursuant to 6 NYCRR §617.5(c)(30) of SEQR, and thus is exempt from environmental review thereunder.
- 4. The proposed Local Law No. 2 of 2022 is hereby referred to the Cayuga County Planning Board for review pursuant to General Municipal Law §239(l-m).
- 5. The Town Council will conduct a Public Hearing at the Owasco Town Hall on **July 14, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.,** or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, for the purpose of taking public comment on, and giving due consideration to, the enactment of proposed Local Law No. 2 of 2022.
