#### **COMMUNICATIONS**

- The town did better than expected with the sales tax revenue during this pandemic.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Drafting letter to NYS Comptroller's office regarding the Highway Department Audit findings. The Town will begin working on the corrective action plan after the draft letter has been sent.

\*Supervisor Wagner stated that the board agreed with the findings and he would be sending out a reply letter early next week. The town has 90 days to write a corrective action plan.

Sewer equiptment upgrade:

The highway superintendent Bob Bruno and Supervisor Wagner had a demo of a ECO Model 900 Sewer Cleaning & Maintance truck and discussed an all in one unit like this model vs a tow behind unit. The town had an overflow last month and needed to sub hire the City of Auburn's sewer department resulting in a high bill from the city.

The Supervisor will also look into possibly a shared ownership with another municipality.
