Jim Davia- Melrose Rd, addressed the board again with concerns of neighbors having outside wood burning fires, as it is offensive and he and his wife must stay inside and shut their windows.

Nate VeVone addressed the board with concerns of speeding and the running of a stop sign and the corner of Letchworth and Vanduyne Ave, Nate showed a video of car after car running the stop sign at a high rate of speed, with many children and walkers in the area at the same time.

*Lieutenant Michele Wellauer with the Cayuga County Sherriff's office addressed the town board and the residents as they receive many calls on a daily bases from all over the county

with the same issues. He stated that right now the county is short 9 deputies, however they have a few in the academy right now and will be beefing up patrols soon. The Sheriff's office has also received a grant and will be purchasing remote speed sensors that they will soon begin using. Lt. Wellauer also stated they will try to get some patrols around the town to address this issue.

Maryanne White, Zoar Street addressed the board with concerns of the small creek that runs behind her home on Letchworth, if the new owner puts in a culvert she is worried the yards will not have a place to drain, and or will the culvert be large enough the handle the water or will there be an overflow onto their properties. She also would like to know who actually owns the creek.

*Supervisor Wagner explained to all that Cayuga County Soil and Water have been evaluating and will be further evaluating the flow. Ed is waiting for a return reply from CC Soil & Water regarding the issue. Ed also stated that it may not be a creek it may be seasonal stream, or drainage ditch.

Gloria Cuddy also addressed the board will concerns of the creek flow, she also stated that it needs to be dredged again as it is full of weeds and is restricting the flow.

*Attorney Riccardo Galbato stated that the flow of water cannot be impeded by anyone.

Mr. Warren of Stryker Ave, asked if you could have a copy of the PDD.

*Supervisor Wagner stated absolutely, as it is public information, stop by Town Hall during normal hours of operation and pick it up.
