<u>RESOLUTION 17-065</u> to authorize the Town Supervisor to sign Change Order No. 1 for the Owasco Water District Improvements: Phase I Contract No. 1.

WHEREAS, this Change Order includes the following additional work items:

<u>Description and Reason for Change Order:</u> This Change Order includes the following additional work items:

Highlander Construction had to tap an 8" DI water main that runs to the current Melrose Road tank. Originally, an abandoned water main (that was thought to be the correct main) was tapped. This was an unforeseen condition as all the available drawings and records showed the abandoned water main as a live water main. It was agreed upon by Town representatives and Highlander Construction at a job meeting to perform this work on a Time and materials basis. The cost of this change order DOES NOT include restoration.

<u>Change Order Cost:</u> This change order has a cost of \$33,608.74. The amount was verified by the Town's onsite representatives.

<u>Time Extension</u>: A 30 day time extension will be provided through the execution of this Change Order. All work of the Contract shall be substantially completed by March 31, 2017.

<u>Resolution 17-068</u> to approve a Negative Declaration under SEQRA for the Town of Owasco Playground improvement project.

RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PROPOSED TOWN OF OWASCO PLAYGROUND AND SPLASH PAD PROJECT IS AN UNLISTED ACTION AND WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT ADVERSE IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Owasco (the "Town") is proposing to complete the Town of Owasco Playground and Splash Pad Project in Owasco, Cayuga County, New York (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law, as amended, the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and the implementing regulations at 6 NYCRR Part 617 (the "Régulations"), the Town desires to comply with SEQRA and the Regulations with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, on <u>January 23, 2017</u> the Town authorized a letter and Part 1 of the Short Environmental Assessment Form (SEAF) to be sent to other potentially "involved agencies" and "interested agencies" (as these quoted terms are defined in the Regulations), indicating the Town

of Owasco Town Board's ("Town Board") desire to serve as "lead agency" (as this quoted term is defined in the Regulations) for a coordinated review under SEQRA of the Project; and

WHEREAS, each of the involved agencies or potentially involved agencies has agreed to or raised no objections to the Town Board serving as lead agency of the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Regulations, the Town Board has considered the significance of the potential environmental impacts of the Project by (a) using the criteria specified in Section 617.7 of the Regulations, and (b) examining the SEAF for the Project, including the facts and conclusions in Parts 1, 2 and 3 of the SEAF, and (c) thoroughly analyzing the areas of relevant environmental concern.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that based upon an examination of the SEAF and based further upon the Town Board's knowledge of the area surrounding the Project and such further investigations of the Project and its potential environmental impact as the Town Board has deemed appropriate, the Town Board makes the following findings and determinations: the Project constitutes an "unlisted action" (as the quoted term is defined in the Regulations); and no significant adverse environmental impacts are noted in the SEAF for the Project and none are known to the Town Board. Therefore, the Town Board hereby determines that the Project will not have a significant adverse environmental impact and will not require the preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement with respect to the Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that as a consequence of such findings and declaration and in compliance with the requirements of SEQRA and the Regulations, the Town Board, as stated in the Determination of Significance section of the completed Short Environmental Assessment Form, hereby directs the Town Supervisor to issue a Negative Declaration determination in accordance with 6 NYCRR § 617.12; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board directs the Town Supervisor to publish notice of and file a copy of the Negative Declaration for the Project in accordance with the Regulations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
