FURTHER RESOLVED in the event attendee's personal expenses exceed the \$300 advance, an itemized request for reimbursement accompanied by supporting receipts shall be required. FURTHER RESOLED upon reviewing requests for reimbursement the town board will evaluate the necessity of the expense prior to approval of the reimbursement. There is no reimbursement for Alcoholic Beverages or any Sales Tax.

Resolution 11-22 to approve the twelve month contract for 2011 between Finger Lakes Dog Protection Agency, INC. and the Town of Owasco for \$4620. payable in twelve monthly installments of three hundred eighty five dollars (\$385.00), \$25.00 fee per call for non-emergency after hour responses, \$8.00 per day for dog boarding fee for dogs seized and impounded, in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law and/or any local law of ordinance. Transfer or euthanasia and disposal at the rate of \$40.00 per dog. The town shall be responsible for veterinary service cost for unidentified seized and /or impounded dogs during the statutory redemption period.
