<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Representative from NYS DOT will discuss the process regarding new traffic study, and the possibility of a reduction of the speed limit on NYS Route 38A.

Resolved: The NYS DOT addressed the Town Board and those in attendance as to how they would conduct the study regarding the speed limit on Rt. 38A. They are going to try and expedite the study and have already begun looking at the data. They have met with the NYS Troopers and found over 400 tickets were issued since January of 2016, with approx. 113 issued for speeding. They will begin the road study and start with radar and different points and times. They will also look at different egress and ingress of intersections, fire lanes, curves, bends in the road, distance off the road, reported accidents, etc. They will drive the road and different speeds, and consult with the troopers, sheriff's and school transportation office.
