<u>RESOLUTION 17-181 to</u> authorizes and directs Supervisor Ed Wagner to execute a new fourparty agreement between the City of Auburn, the Town of Owasco, the County of Cayuga and the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council and to work directly with the four parties on the New Agreement

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn and the Town of Owasco, in their roles as purveyors of public water sourced from Owasco Lake and sold by the City of Auburn and Town of Owasco directly or indirectly to approximately forty-five thousand water users within Cayuga County, have established under New York State Public Health Law the rules and regulations for the protection from contamination of the waters of Owasco Lake and this public water supply and to all watercourses tributary thereto or which may ultimately discharge into Owasco Lake (the Owasco Lake Watershed Rules & Regulations); and

WHEREAS, in recognition and response to the responsibility to protect this public water resource, the City of Auburn and Town of Owasco, together with Cayuga County, established, as Founding Members, the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council, Inc., and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1411 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law and a Certificate of Incorporation filed with the New York Secretary of State on the 23rd day of February, 2011, the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council, Inc. (the "Corporation") was officially established as a not-for-profit, local development corporation to lessen the burdens of government and act in the public interest in a number of ways, including undertaking programs and activities in furtherance of managing, monitoring and protecting the water resources of Owasco Lake and the water resources within the Owasco Lake Watershed for the well-being and benefit of the residents of Cayuga County; and

WHEREAS, a primary purpose of the Corporation is to ensure the monitoring, and inspection of Owasco Lake and its Watershed, or to cause to be inspected, those activities and circumstances within the Owasco Lake and its Watershed that may impact the quality and general health of the waters of Owasco Lake or the water resources of the Owasco Lake Watershed; and

WHEREAS, a Watershed Inspection Committee comprised of Corporation Directors representing the City of Auburn, Town of Owasco and Cayuga County, was established as a standing committee of the Corporation to oversee and manage the operation and implementation of the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, at the time of its formation, the Corporation was unable to assume full administration of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the Cayuga County Soil and Water Conservation District (CCSWCD) agreed to provide administrative oversight of the Program until such time as the Corporation was able to assume full and ongoing administration of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the CCSWCD currently provides such administrative support for the Program, utilizing annual funding support provided jointly by the City of Auburn and the Town of Owasco under a four-party agreement with the City of Auburn, the Town of Owasco, the County of Cayuga and the Cayuga County Soil & Water Conservation District, as parties to the agreement, with such agreement defining the roles and responsibilities of the parties and the associated funding structure supporting the Program (the "Current Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2017, the Corporation and its Board of Directors approved a Board Resolution (the "August 15 Resolution") confirming the Board's determination that the Corporation is ready, willing and able to assume full administration of the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program, and that doing so will be in the best interest of the Program and the ongoing water quality improvement initiatives focused and Owasco Lake and it's watershed; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation has forwarded a certified copy of the August 15 Resolution to each of the four parties to the Current Agreement, seeking their unified action and cooperation in transitioning administration of the Program from the CCSWCD to the Corporation by collectively terminating the Current Agreement and simultaneously executing a new four party agreement under which the Corporation can realize its goal of administering the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program going forward; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Owasco wishes to support the proposed transition of the Program to the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council, NOW, THERFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town of Owasco as follows:

SECTION 1. The Town of Owasco, hereby express their appreciation and thanks to the Cayuga County Soil & Water Conservation District Board of Directors, Executive Director and staff for the administrative support provided to the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program during its formative years as the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council built its organizational and operational capacity to assume the full administrative responsibility and oversight for the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program.

SECTION 2. The Town of Owasco, hereby requests the termination of the Current Agreement to be effective on or about the date of January 4, 2018.

SECTION 3. The Town of Owasco, hereby authorizes and directs Supervisor Ed Wagner to execute a new four-party agreement between the City of Auburn, the Town of Owasco, the County of Cayuga and the Owasco Lake Watershed Management Council, attached hereto and made a part of this resolution hereof, under which the full administrative responsibility for the Owasco Lake Watershed Inspection Program and employment of the Watershed Specialist and Watershed Inspectors (the staff) will transition to the Corporation (the "New Agreement"), on or about the date of January 4, 2018.

SECTION 4. The Town of Owasco, hereby authorizes and directs the Supervisor Ed Wagner to work directly with the four parties to the New Agreement to bring about the intent of this Resolution, and further, it hereby directs and authorizes the Town of Owasco, to execute any and all documents necessary and appropriate to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
