<u>PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:</u> Mr. Chet Crosby addressed the board regarding a previous conversation regarding controlling the deer population.

*Supervisor Wagner stated he had made an initial movement and had conversations with the DEC, at this time the town has many capital projects going on and have put it aside for the moment.

Terry Lattimore addressed the board with numerous concerns regarding the presentation of the Comprehensive Plan for 2016. His main concern was the reference to the waterway, Mr. Lattimore was worried the plan referenced a path on land through resident's property ending at Emerson Park.

*Supervisor Wagner and Amanda Mazzoni stated that was not the plan, the referred waterway is from the consisting 2002 Comprehensive Plan and it the waterway that is in the outlet itself, not on land.

Another Concern from Mr. Lattimore, Mr. Paul Sedor, and Mr. Ranauro addressed another concern in the comprehensive plan. The plan earmarks public access for recreational use of town property, where the town owns a pump station.

Mr. Ranauro was the previous owner of the said property, and now lives next door, the town took ownership of the property by eminent domain, and Mr. Ranauro states when the land was taken it was stated that the land could not be used for public use.

Mr. Paul Sedor also addressed the board as his son owns property on the other side of the referenced public access spot. He stated that his son has been trying to purchase a portion of the property for a driveway and the town board has not approved the deal.

Mr. Sedor was also concerned with the Fees that Emerson Park charges for public use.

Supervisor Wagner addressed their concerns, the property has been referenced in the Comprehensive plan as a possible launch for canoes to access the outlet. It is only referenced not acted or agreed upon.

In regards Mr. Sedor's statement on the Fees at Emerson Park, both Supervisor Wagner & Councilmen Gucciardi stated that the park is managed by Cayuga County, and they should contact their Legislators with the fee issue.

<u>COMMUNICATIONS:</u> The Town received a letter from the City of Auburn asking for support from the Town of Owasco so they may apply for a grant to study the sewer & waste water county wide.
