# Resolution 16-231 TO APPROVE SEQRA DETERMINATION FOR THE TOWN OF OWASCO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

A Resolution to Issue a Determination of Environmental Significance FOR THE TOWN OF OWASCO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

**WHEREAS,** by Resolution 16-166 adopted on 7.14.16 the Town Board determined that the proposed action is a Type 1 Action under the State Environmental Quality Review (SEQRA) Regulations; and

**WHEREAS,** by Resolution 16-166 adopted on 7.14.16 the Town Board declared it is the intent of the Town Board to assume the role of "Lead Agency" for purposes of conducting a SEQRA review of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Owasco circulated said Part 1 of the Full Environmental Assessment Form to the following list of "Interested and Involved Agencies" (Cayuga County Planning Department, County of Cayuga, City of Auburn, Town of Sennett, Town of Niles, Town of Fleming, Cayuga County Health Department) under cover of the "Notice of Intent to Establish Lead Agency" letter for purposes of establishing Lead Agency status under the SEQRA; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board caused Part 2 of the Full Environmental Assessment Form to be prepared for use to assess the potential environmental impacts associated with enactment of the proposed local law.

**BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Owasco Town Board has determined that the adoption of the Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and hereby issues a Negative Declaration.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Town Supervisor be and is hereby directed to sign the Negative Declaration of Environmental Significance.

# Resolution 16-232 TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE TOWN OF OWASCO COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

**WHEREAS,** a Resolution <u>16-164</u> was adopted by the Town Board on <u>July 14, 2016</u> introducing the proposed Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan and said Resolution established a public hearing relating thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, a Notice of Public Hearing with respect to said proposed Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan was duly published in The Citizen, the official Town newspaper and a newspaper circulated in said Town on <u>July 2016</u>, and proof of such publication has been filed with the Town Clerk, and

**WHEREAS,** a Notice of Public Hearing with respect to such Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan was duly posted on the sign board of the Owasco Town Hall, and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing upon said proposed Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan was held at the Owasco Town Hall, 2 Bristol Avenue, Auburn, New York 13021, in the Town of Owasco, New York on 7.14.16, pursuant to such Notice and an opportunity to be heard was given at said hearing to those favoring or opposing passage of said proposed Local Law; and WHEREAS, the proposed Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan was referred to the Cayuga County General Municipal Law 239-l, m & n Review Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan was referred to the Town of Owasco Planning Board and Zoning Board of Appeals; and

**WHEREAS,** by letter dated 9.15.16 the Cayuga County Planning Board recommended approving the proposed action without change; and

WHEREAS, the Owasco Town Board by Resolution passed on this date issued a Negative

Declaration under SEQRA for Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has carefully considered the proposed Town of Owasco

Comprehensive Plan, and after due deliberation, finds it is in the best interest of the Town of

Owasco to adopt said Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan.

## NOW, THEREFORE, AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION, IT IS HEREBY

**RESOLVED,** that the Town Board of the Town of Owasco hereby approves and adopts Town of Owasco Comprehensive Plan.

<u>Resolution 16-233</u> to approve discontinuance of the white Owasco recycling stickers that had been previously purchased by residents prior to February 10, 2016, the discontinuance will take effective on January 1, 2017.

Whereas: We -Care has been managing the Owasco Recycling Center since February 10, 2016 and has continued to accept the white stickers sold before February 10, 2016.

<u>Whereas:</u> The Town of Owasco has reimbursed We- Care for the stickers they have collected on site, since February 10, 2016.

<u>Whereas:</u> Residents have had ample time to use the previously purchase stickers. The Town will not reimburse any unused stickers.

<u>Whereas:</u> The town will post notice at the recycling center, immediately notifying residents of the discontinuance of use of the sticker's effective date of January 1, 2017. Residents will continue to purchase the recycling center sticker from We -Care directly at the Recycling Center.

<u>Resolved:</u> effective January 1 2017 the Town of Owasco will not sell the We- Care recycling stickers at the town hall. Effective January 1, 2017 the town board approves a rate increase for the We-Care stickers from \$2.75 to \$3.00. We care will reimburse the Town of Owasco .10 cents per sticker for rental of facility and related expenses.

# TOWN BOARD – TOWN OF OWASCO RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT

Rozwood/Ward Assessment Litigation (2015, 2016 Years)

WHEREAS, in July 2015 and 2016 Petitioner Elizabeth Rozwood (now Elizabeth Ward) commenced proceedings challenging the assessment on property she owns within the Town, namely Rozwood fka Ward v. Owasco et al. Index No. 15-0733 and Rozwood fka Ward v. Owasco Index No. 16-0620; and

WHEREAS, the County intervened in these proceedings but the School District did not; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner has proposed a settlement offer which would discontinue the 2015 proceeding and reduce the property's assessment to \$300,447 for 2016 contingent upon Petitioner receiving a reduced 2017 Town and County tax bill and refunds from the School District for the overpayment of its second School tax installment payment only; and

WHEREAS, the Town's special counsel and Town Attorney believe that settlement in accordance with the terms stated are preferable to the risk and expense of a trial in this case; and

WHEREAS, the County Attorney has advised that the proposed settlement is acceptable to the County Legislature as well.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board as follows:

Section 1. The Board authorizes its Special Counsel to settle these tax assessment proceedings by discontinuing the 2015 year and reducing the property's assessment to \$300,447 for 2016 only.

Section 2. The Town/County tax bill shall be reduced to \$300,447 and there shall be no refunds paid.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly put to a vote and which passed the Town Board. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.
