<u>Resolution 16-212 B</u> A Resolution of the Town Board for the adoption and enactment of Local Law No. 3 of 2016

WHEREAS, a Resolution 16-095 was adopted by the Town Board on April 14, 2016 introducing proposed Local Law No. 3 of 2016 and said Resolution established a public hearing relating thereto; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing with respect to said proposed Local Law was duly published in The Citizen, the official Town newspaper and a newspaper circulated in said Town on October 7, 2016, and proof of such publication has been filed with the Town Clerk, and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing with respect to such Local Law was duly posted on the sign board of the Owasco Town Hall, and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing upon said proposed Local Law was held at the Owasco Town Hall, 2 Bristol Avenue, Auburn, New York 13021, in the Town of Owasco, New York on this date, pursuant to such Notice and an opportunity to be heard was given at said hearing to those favoring or opposing passage of said proposed Local Law; and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law does not require review by the Cayuga County General Municipal Law 239-1,m & n Review Committee as it is not a zoning law; and

WHEREAS, the Owasco Town Board by Resolution passed on this date issued a Negative Declaration under SEQRA for Local Law No. 3 of 2016.

WHEREAS, the Town Board has carefully considered the proposed Local Law; and

after due deliberation, finds it is in the best interest of the Town of Owasco to adopt said

Local Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, AFTER DUE CONSIDERATION, IT IS HEREBY,

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Owasco hereby approves and enacts Local Law No. 3 of 2016 set forth below:

Local Law No. 3 of 2016 to amend Chapter 119 Solid Waste, Section 119-3 of the Town of Owasco

Section 119-3 of the Owasco Town Code is amended, in its entirety, as follows:

"§ 119-3. Recycling Center rules.

A. The following activities are prohibited: (1) Entering or using the Recycling Center at times other than the hours set forth in § <u>119-4</u> of this article for disposal of garbage, trash, or refuse. However, the disposal of brush, grass, leaves, and metal in their properly designated areas is permitted at any time.

Disposal of any garbage, trash, or refuse without the use of Town of Owasco authorized tags/stickers.

(3)

Disposal of any household appliance containing freon gas.

(4)

Disposal of any building materials.

(5) Disposal of tires.

B.

Miscellaneous.

(1)

Use of the Recycling Center is limited to Owasco Town residents and Owasco property owners only, with the following exception:

[Amended 11-13-2008 by L.L. No. 4-2008]

The Director of Public Works and/or Refuse and Garbage Manager, in his sole discretion, upon presentation of satisfactory proof, may grant permission to a contractor hired by an Owasco Town resident or Owasco property owner or a governmental entity to use the Recycling Center for a specific purpose and limited period of time, subject to the laws, regulations and rules of the Town of Owasco; and

(2)

Owasco Town residents and property owners may purchase Town of Owasco authorized tags/stickers at the Recycling Center or the Owasco Town Hall during normal business hours.

(3)

Bulk items, such as furniture and household appliances not containing freon, may be disposed of after making prior arrangements with a Recycling Center employee or authorized agent and paying the associated disposal fee. A fee schedule is available at the Recycling Center or the Owasco Town Hall. Said fees may be established and adjusted by resolution of the Town Board. [Amended 5-9-2013 by L.L. No. 4-2013]

WHEREAS, on January 27, 2016 the Town Board passed Resolution 16-044, established the control systems of Aqualogics Systems Inc. as its standard and authorizes the standardization for the Town Water District and Town Sewer Districts Nos. 1, 2 and 3, as well as replacement parts.

WHEREAS, this Purchase Order includes the following additional work items:

The radios that communicate with the Owasco SCADA system are out of date and need to be replaced. Replacing these radios are included at the Oakridge Pump Station, the Burtis Point Pump Station, and the new Town Hall Water Tank under the original projects. If one radio is upgraded, all the radios in the Town need to be upgraded. The Oakridge and Burtis Point Pump Stations radios will be upgraded first as a result of the sewer project and will therefore force the replacement of every other radio in the Town.

Purchase Order Cost: The execution of this change will include all labor and materials to replace all the radios that communicate with the Owasco SCADA system. The cost of this change order will be split between the Owasco Water District Improvements project and the EFC funded Owasco Sewer District Improvements Project.

<u>RESOLUTION 16-219</u> To authorize the Town Supervisor to sign Change Order No. 6a for the Owasco Sewer System Improvements Project Contract No. 1.

WHEREAS, this Change Order includes the following additional work items:

During the design phase of the project, the Town of Owasco requested for a meter to be installed at the north end of Sewer District 3 along the low pressure sewer main prior to the discharge into Sewer District 2. The meter was not included in the original project due to budget concerns, but serves very useful purposes. This meter will not only track flows from Sewer District 3, but also help indicate the amount of inflow/infiltration the sewer district may be experiencing.

Part A (this part) of Change Order 6 will include the furnish and install of a magnetic flow meter into a meter manhole. Part A of Change Order 6 will also include the furnish and install of the meter manhole, all piping, valves, and bypass piping around the manhole.

Part B of Change Order 6 will include all the electrical and instrumentation/control work necessary for this change order. The final details of Part B are not yet available and therefore Part B of Change 6 will be subject to approval at a later date.

<u>Change Order Cost</u>: The execution of this Change Order will result in the addition of Bid Item "CO6a-1 – Furnish and Install SD3 Meter, Piping, and Meter Manhole". This Bid Item will have a total lump sum cost of \$14,000.00. This change order will pay for an item in Sewer District 3 and therefore shall be paid 100% by Sewer District 3. This change order does not include costs associate with Part B.

<u>Time Extension</u>: No time extension will be provided through the execution of this Change Order.

WHEREAS, the execution of this Change Order will result in an increase in approximately **\$14,000.00** to the Contract Amount.

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed consist of the construction and maintenance of sanitary sewer system to serve said extension in the district in accordance with certain plans to be submitted to the Town by the Town Engineer, and

WHEREAS, on 1.4.16, 4.26.16 and 7.1.16 the Town Board duly adopted a Resolution directing that the Town Clerk call a Public Hearing for the proposed Sewer District No. 3 Extensions; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing Notice reciting a description of the boundaries of the proposed extension was duly published in The Citizen on July 13, 2016 for a Public Hearing on Thursday, August 11, 2016 at 5:00 P.M. on the proposed Sewer District No. 3 Extension; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing was conducted on August 11, 2016 and closed the same date;

WHEREAS, the Town Board declared itself lead agency and that said action is an Unlisted Action under SEQRA and provided a Short Environmental Assessment Form to the Cayuga County Health Department, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the City of Auburn for any comments; and **WHEREAS,** the Town Engineer will work with the DEC for any additional specifications that may be required for these extensions and has communicated with Seth Jensen of the City of Auburn;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Owasco as lead agency hereby determines that the proposed action will not result in any significant environmental impacts and issues a Negative Declaration under SEQRA and the Town Supervisor is authorized to sign Part III of the Short Environmental Assessment Form dated October 13, 2016; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Owasco that it be and hereby is determined as follows:

- 1. The notice of hearing was published and posted as required by law and is otherwise sufficient.
- 2. That all of the property and property owners, within the proposed sewer district extension are benefited thereby.
- 3. That all of the property and property owners benefited are included within the proposed sewer district extension.
- 4. It is in the public interest to extend the sewer district, as described in the Petition, Public Hearing Notice and this Resolution; and be it
