Resolution 14-090 to amend a Building Permit Fee for properties qualifying for an Agricultural Assessment

Town of Owasco Code Section 50-16 states:

A fee schedule shall be established by resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Owasco. Such fee schedule may thereafter be amended from time to time by like resolution. The fees set forth in, or determined in accordance with, such fee schedule or amended fee schedule shall be charged and collected for the submission of applications, the issuance of building permits, amended building permits, renewed building permits, certificates of occupancy/certificates of compliance, temporary certificates, operating permits, fire safety and property maintenance inspections, and other actions of the Code Enforcement Officer described in or contemplated by this chapter.

Pursuant to Section 50-16 of the Owasco Town Code, the Town Board hereby Storage Buildings (barns) and garages for use in a parcel that qualifies for an Agricultural Assessment shall have no building permit fee but still be required to obtain a building permit issued by the Town.

For purposes of this Resolution a parcel that qualifies for an Agricultural Assessment is one in which the owner of said parcel has applied for and been accepted by the Town Assessor per New York State Agricultural Assessment Application Form RP-305 as amended from time to time. All other Building Permit Fees adopted on August 14, 2008 by Resolution 08-157 and Amended on October 9, 2008 by Resolution 08-207 are still in full force and effect.

Resolution 14-093 Establishing a Capital Reserve Fund to Finance a "Type" of Capital Improvement or Equipment; Town Hall Building, Alterations and Land or Site, Acquisition, Repair and Maintenance Reserve Fund

RESOLVED, that pursuant to section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, as amended, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the "Town Hall Building, Alterations and Land or Site Purchase, Acquisition, Repair and Maintenance Reserve Fund" (also hereinafter referred to as "Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund"). The purpose of this Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund is to accumulate moneys to finance the cost of Town Hall Building, Alterations and Land or Site, Acquisition, Repair and Maintenance Reserve Fund for the Town. The type of capital improvement to be financed from the Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund is the acquisition of Town Hall Building, Alterations and Land or Site, Acquisition, Repair and Maintenance Reserve Fund for the Town.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chief fiscal officer or Town Supervisor is hereby directed to deposit and secure the moneys of this <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u> in the manner provided by section 10 of the General Municipal Law. The Town Board may invest the moneys in the <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u> in the manner provided by section 11 of the General Municipal Law, and consistent with the investment policy of the Town of Owasco. Any interest earned or capital gains realized on the moneys so deposited or invested shall accrue to and become part of the <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u>. The chief financial officer or Town Supervisor shall account for the <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u> in a manner, which maintains the separate identity of the <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u> and shows the date and amount of each sum paid into the fund, interest earned by the fund, capital gains or losses resulting from the sale of investments of the fund, the amount and date of each withdrawal from the fund and total assets of the fund, showing cash balance and a schedule of investments and shall, at the end of each fiscal year, render to the Town Board a detailed report of the operation and condition of the <u>Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund</u>.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that except as otherwise provided by section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, expenditures from this Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund shall be made only for the purpose for which the Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund is established. No expenditure shall be made from this Town Hall Land and Building Reserve Fund without the approval of the Town Board and without such additional actions or proceedings as may be required by section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, including a permissive referendum if required by subdivision 4 of Section 6-c [subdivision 7 of Section 6-g].

Resolution 14-094 Establishing a Capital Reserve Fund to Finance a "Type" of Capital Improvement or Equipment; Water District Building and Site Repairs and Maintenance and Equipment Reserve Fund

RESOLVED, that pursuant to section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, as amended, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the "Water District Building and Site Repairs and Maintenance and Equipment Reserve Fund" (also hereinafter referred to as "Water Reserve Fund"). The purpose of this Water Reserve Fund is to accumulate moneys to finance the cost of Equipment for the Town. The type of equipment to be financed from the Water Reserve Fund is the acquisition of Water District Building and Site Repairs and Maintenance and Equipment for the Town.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chief fiscal officer or Town Supervisor is hereby directed to deposit and secure the moneys of this <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> in the manner provided by section 10 of the General Municipal Law. The Town Board may invest the moneys in the <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> in the manner provided by section 11 of the General Municipal Law, and consistent with the investment policy of the Town of Owasco. Any interest earned or capital gains realized on the moneys so deposited or invested shall accrue to and become part of the <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> in a manner, which maintains the separate identity of the <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> and shows the date and amount of each sum paid into the fund, interest earned by the fund, capital gains or losses resulting from the sale of investments of the fund, the amount and date of each withdrawal from the fund and total assets of the fund, showing cash balance and a schedule of investments and shall, at the end of each fiscal year, render to the Town Board a detailed report of the operation and condition of the <u>Water Reserve Fund</u>.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that except as otherwise provided by section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, expenditures from this <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> shall be made only for the purpose for which the <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> is established. No expenditure shall be made from this <u>Water Reserve Fund</u> without the approval of the Town Board and without such additional actions or proceedings as may be required by section 6-c [6-g] of the General Municipal Law, including a permissive referendum if required by subdivision 4 of Section 6-c [subdivision 7 of Section 6-g].

Resolution 14-095 to amend a portion of Section 807 of the Town of Owasco Employee Handbook

Paragraph labeled "Eligibility" only of Section 807 of the Town of Owasco Employee Handbook is hereby amended to read as follows:

807 Medical Insurance for Retirees

> Eligibility -- To be eligible for coverage, the retiree must meet each of these requirements: (1) have at least twenty years of continuous service with the Town either as a full-time employee or as a full-time Elected Official, as that term is defined for coverage under this Section 807; (2) have retired directly from the Town; (3) be at least fifty-five years of age; and (4) have been granted a retirement benefit from the New York State Employees' Retirement System. These eligibility requirements are subject to change by resolution of the Town Board.

In all other respects Section 807 remains unchanged.

This amendment to Section 807 shall take effect immediately.
